Each team will be made up of two technical undergraduates (from computer science or a related discipline), plus two non-technical team members from areas such as social sciences, philosophy, business (and who have an interest in ethics) from <u>any UK University</u>.

Accommodation and travel bursaries are available, but preference will be given to those within a 30-mile radius.
